TOWN OF ATKINSON BRUSH DUMP AND RECYCLE MATERIALS

Located on: Pope Road, (opposite tennis courts off Westside Drive)

Open: • Wednesday-Noon to 4:00 pm • Saturday-9:00 am to 4:00 pm • Sunday-9:00 am to 4:00 pm • Closed holidays

BRUSH: Clean Wood with no paint, stain, treatments, or finishes • Brush, no larger than 5 inch in diameter

Mulch Pile: Leaves, clippings, and wood chips only.

MULCH MUST BE SEPARATE FROM THE BRUSH WHEN DUMPING ITEMS

RECYCLE CENTER:

• Mixed Paper (Look on flyer, page 2 to identify) • Commingled Recyclables (Look on flyer, page 2 to identify) • Cardboard (Must be broken and flat)

Permits required for the following. Prices may change without prior notice:

Construction Debris: \$25.00 per truckload. You can also call Waste Management to inquire about getting construction debris removed from your home.

WHAT'S NEW

Effective January 1, 2008, the New Hampshire Legislature passed legislation which bans the disposal of mercury-added products at landfills, transfer stations, or incinerators. This ban applies to business and homeowners alike with no exemptions

Items which cannot be collected within in solid waste stream include: TV's, electronics, fluorescent light tubes, compact fluorescent bulbs, thermostats, electrical switches, mercury button cell batteries, etc.

Homeowners should check with municipal offices for acceptance of these items at local solid waste facilities or household hazardous waste (HHW) collection days. Fluorecnet bulbs, and several other wastes, can be managed appropriately through Waste Management's LampTracker recycling program: visit <http://www.wmlamptracker.com> or call 800-664-1434 for more information. Curbside Recycling Program Guidelines

Commingled Containers - What can be recycled?

Place Acceptable Items in Your Bin

Plastic:

- PET (Look on the bottom
- HDPE to identify)
- Soft Drink and Liquor Bottles
- Milk, Water, Juice Containers
- Laundry, Bleach and Cleaning Containers



Non-Acceptable:

- Plastic Grocery Bags
- Sandwich Bags
- 5 Gallon Pails
- Lids and Caps
- Plastic Silverware
- Glassware
- Needles
- Brittle Dairy Food Containers
- No Container that Previously Held a Hazardous Material

Glass:

- Clear, Brown, Green and Blue Glass
- Food and Beverage Containers

Non-Acceptable:

- Ceramic Cups and Plates
- Drinking Glasses
- Heat Resistant Ovenware
- Light Bulbs
- Mirror and Windowpane Glass

Metals:

- Aluminum Cans (Soft Drink, Juice and other Beverage Cans)
- Steel (Tin, Soup Cans, and Metal Jar Lids)
- Aluminum Pie Tins and Foil
- Aerosol Cans (EMPTY) (Non-Paint or pesticide)

Non-Acceptable:

- Paint Cans, Gas Cans, or any container that had previously contained a hazardous or toxic material

Mixed Paper - What can be recycled?

Place Acceptable Items in Your Bin

Paper (Clean & Dry):

- Newspaper
- Magazines
- Phonebooks
- Old Mail
- Greeting Cards
- Flyers
- Brochures
- Catalogues
- Folders
- Soft Cover Books
- Paper Bags

Paperboard:

(May be mixed with Paper)

- Paper Food Boxes (discard liners)
- Cereal, Rice, Cracker, Pasta, Shoe Boxes
- Paper Towel Rolls, Writing Pad Backs,
- Pizza Boxes (discard liners)

Does it tear? Is it clean? Then recycle it...

Non-Acceptable

- Waxed Paper
- Soiled Paper
- Used Tissues
- Plastic, Wood or Metal
- Dirt or Other Trash
- Plastic Bags

Corrugated Cardboard:

Any Clean "Waffled" Cardboard Box not exceeding **2' X 2' X 2'** when bundled for safety and consistency of collection



HOW TO PREPARE COMMINGLED CONTAINERS FOR COLLECTION

Please!

- All containers must be rinsed and free of all contaminants.
- Keep commingled recyclables (plastic, glass, and metal) separate from your paper
- Keep bin for recyclables separate and away from your household trash so collector can easily identify



HOW TO PREPARE MIXED PAPER FOR COLLECTION

- Remove or Empty All Plastic Bags
- Remove any Non-Acceptable items and discard with your regular trash.
- Place *Mixed Papers* in any Brown Paper Bag, or bundle with string. Then place "bagged" papers on top of or beside "Commingled Containers" and set out by 7:00 am on your collection day.
- Check the weather forecast for high winds or rain and keep your recyclables in for another week or locate the nearest recycling center to drop off your recyclables.
- **Keep your paper separate from the cans, plastics and glass.**

Atkinson 2008-2009 Curbside Recycling Collection Calendar

Recycling in Atkinson is collected at your curb every other week. Your trash collection is every week. Atkinson collection is on Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. Place your trash and Mixed Paper and Commingled Containers at the curb by 7:00 AM. The recycling collection will be on the **Green Weeks** as follows.

White Goods/Electronics Collection

Atkinson residents can now have white goods and electronic items collected from your residence. Residents will be required to contact Waste Management at 800-847-5303 to schedule a pickup and to pay the associated fee. The fees are as follows:

- ◆ Freon Bearing White Good (AC, refrigerator, freezer) - \$40.00 each
- ◆ Non-Freon White Good (Dryer, dishwasher, stove etc) - \$30.00 each
- ◆ Televisions (25" or below) - \$40.00 each
- ◆ Electronics (Computers including peripherals, Stereos, DVD's, printers etc.) - \$30.00 each

Payment by major credit card will be accepted in order to schedule a collection.
